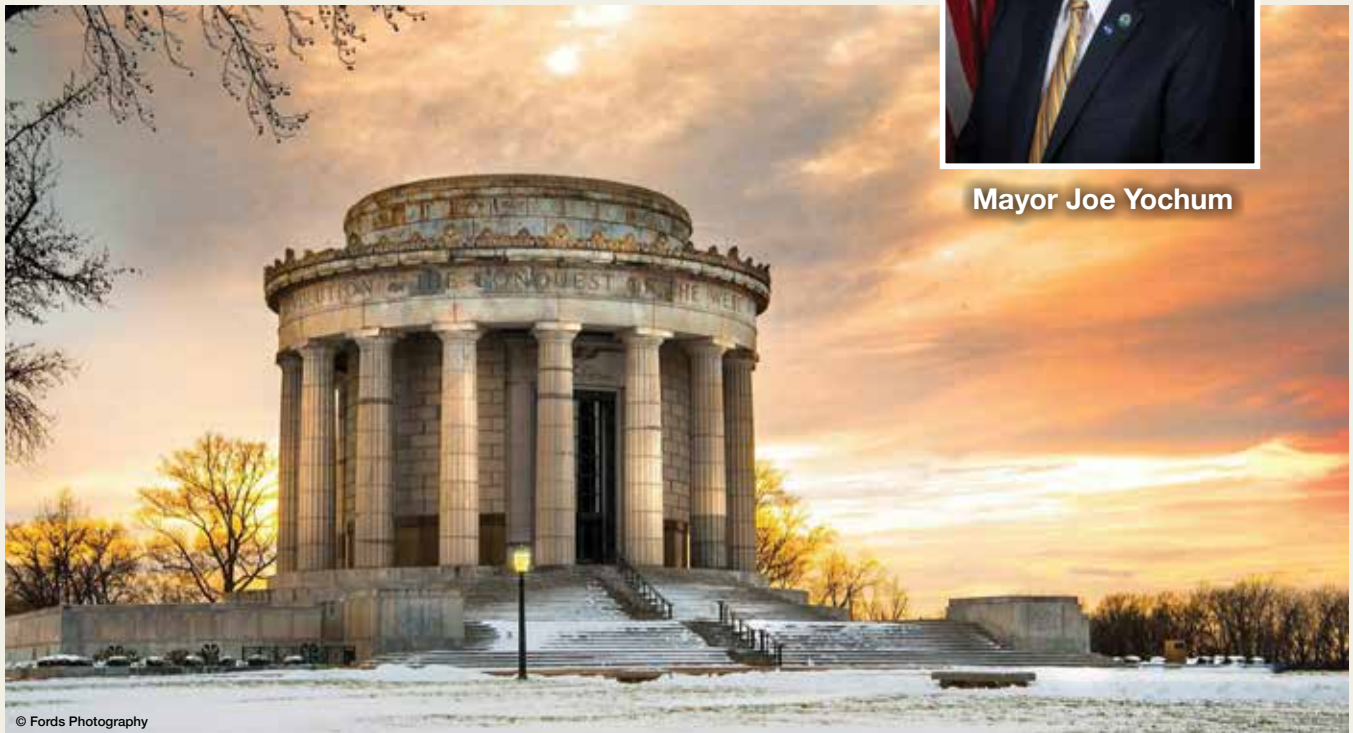

VINCENNES CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Flaget Elementary & Rivet Middle and High School

Vincennes Catholic Schools provide a faith-centered educational option for families in the community. Flaget Elementary School serves students from preschool through fifth grade, focusing on building strong academic foundations in a nurturing learning environment.

Rivet Middle and High School continues that tradition through graduation, offering small class sizes that allow teachers to provide individualized attention and mentorship. Students participate in athletics, academic competitions, and service projects while developing leadership skills grounded in faith and community values.

Education is deeply woven into the fabric of Knox County. Across the community, schools serve as places where students discover their strengths, explore new opportunities, and build the confidence needed for the future. Dedicated teachers, supportive families, and strong community partnerships create learning environments that encourage curiosity, leadership, and achievement. From early childhood classrooms to high school graduation, Knox County schools focus on helping students grow academically while developing the character and skills needed to succeed in life.

Knox County is served by three public school corporations and a Catholic school system, each offering unique opportunities for students. Academic programs range from early college coursework and career training to strong athletics, fine arts, and extracurricular activities. Together, these schools provide a variety of pathways that help students explore their interests and prepare for the future.

VINCENNES COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION

Vincennes Community School Corporation serves the city of Vincennes and surrounding areas with several elementary schools, Clark Middle School, and Lincoln High School, one of the most historic high schools in Indiana. The corporation places a strong emphasis on academic achievement and college readiness. Through partnerships with Vincennes University, students have the opportunity to participate in dual credit and early college programs that allow them to earn college credits while still in high school.

Lincoln High School is also known for its proud athletic tradition and strong school spirit. Students participate in a wide range of activities including athletics, performing arts, academic teams, and student organizations that contribute to a vibrant and supportive school culture.

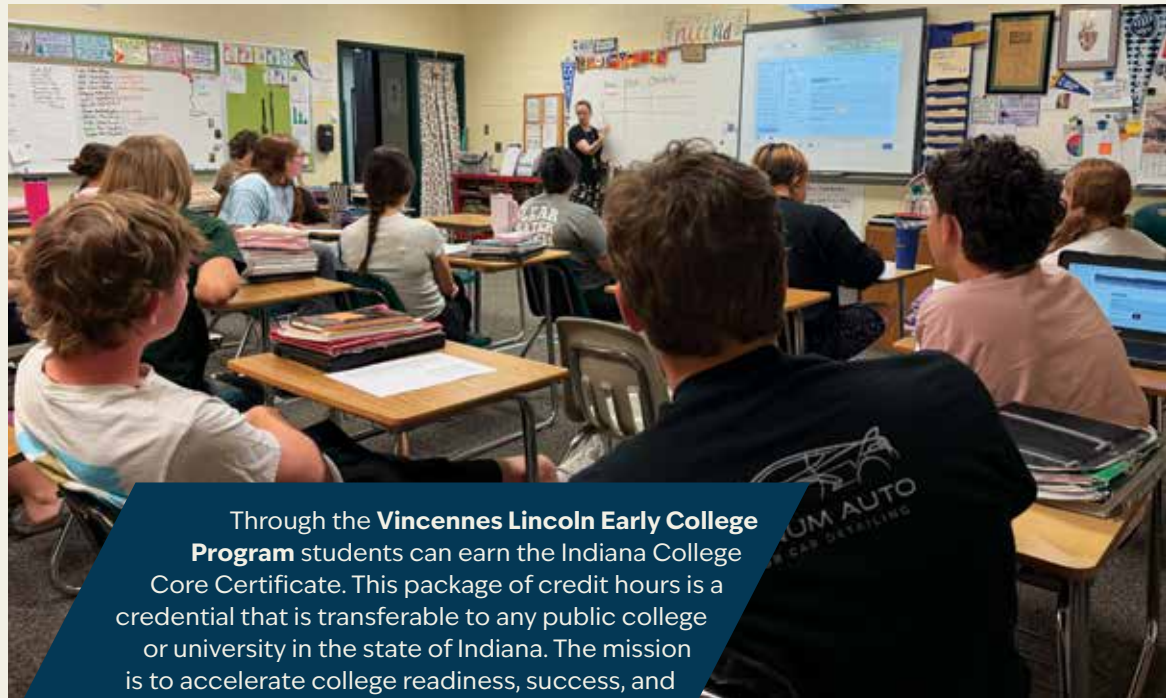

Through the **Vincennes Lincoln Early College Program** students can earn the Indiana College Core Certificate. This package of credit hours is a credential that is transferable to any public college or university in the state of Indiana. The mission is to accelerate college readiness, success, and completion through challenging college credit coursework in a personalized environment with a network of staff, family, and community supports.

SOUTH KNOX SCHOOL CORPORATION

South Knox School Corporation serves the southern portion of Knox County and offers strong academic programming alongside athletics and extracurricular opportunities. South Knox Middle High School focuses on preparing students for college, careers, and community leadership through both classroom learning and hands-on experiences.

The Spartans maintain a strong tradition of school pride and community support. In 2025, the entire community celebrated when the South Knox Girls Basketball team captured the Indiana Class 2A State Championship, bringing the first state title in school history to the district and creating a memorable moment for students, families, and fans.

NORTH KNOX SCHOOL CORPORATION

Smaller class sizes allow teachers to build strong relationships with students while providing individualized support.

North Knox Junior Senior High School offers a variety of academic courses, leadership opportunities, and student organizations. The Warriors compete in the Blue Chip Conference, where student athletes regularly represent their school with pride while building teamwork and sportsmanship.

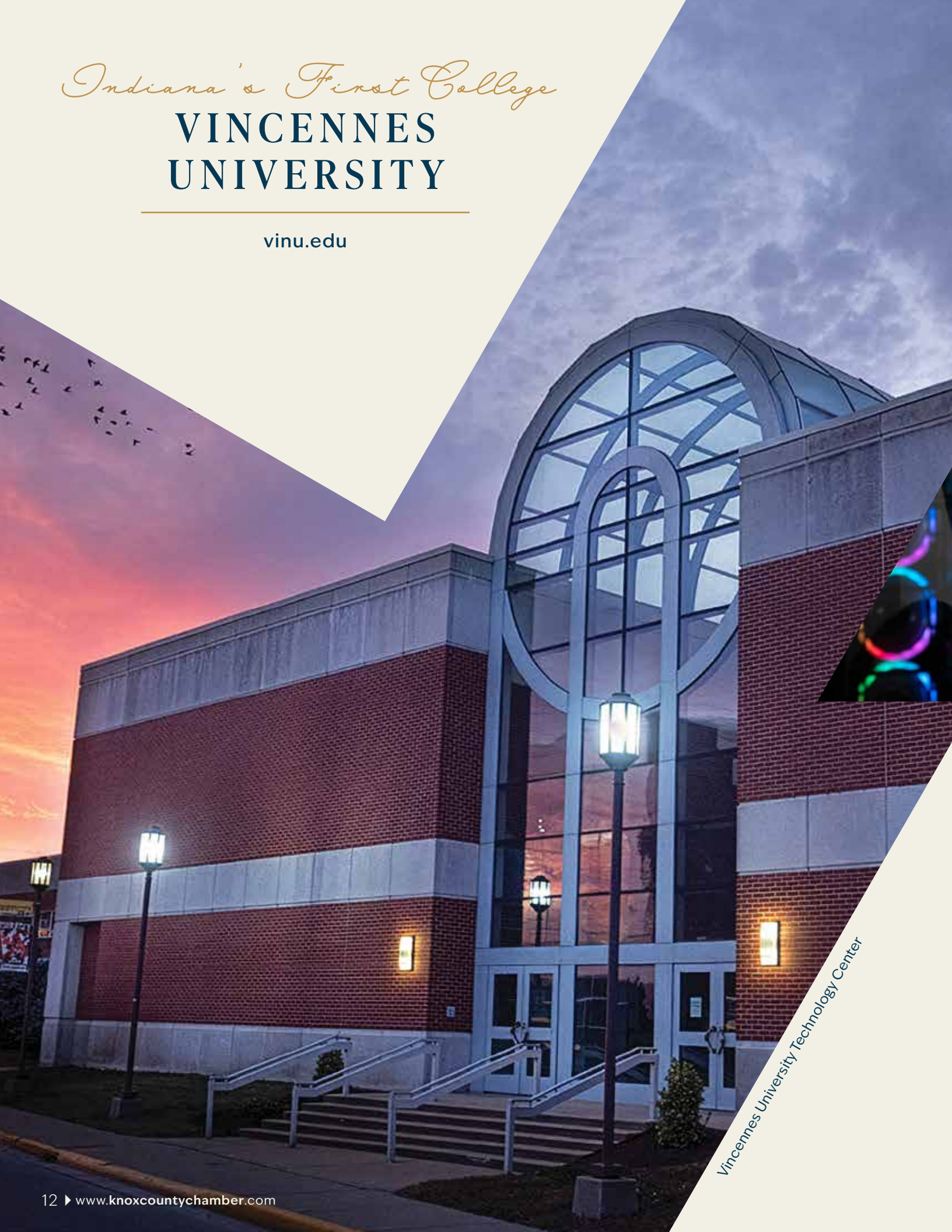

Vincennes University Technology Center

Vincennes University is state-supported with campuses in Vincennes and Jasper, the Aviation Technology Center and American Sign Language program in Indianapolis, Early College Career and Technical Education Centers, and additional sites such as the Gene Haas Training and Education Center in Lebanon, the Logistics Training and Education Center in Plainfield, and the Gibson County Center for Advanced Manufacturing and Logistics in Fort Branch. VU offers online degrees and classes to students who need access to college courses and flexibility through its Distance Education.

A leader in dual credit and career and technical education statewide, VU also offers instruction at military sites throughout the nation.

In addition to offering a wide range of associate degree and certificate programs, VU also offers bachelor's degree programs in technology, homeland security, nursing, health care services administration, secondary education programs in mathematics and science, and special education/elementary education.

VU enrolls students from throughout Indiana, 39 other states, and 16 other countries. Tuition and fees are the lowest among Indiana campuses with residence halls. VU is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission.

Founded in 1801, VU is Indiana's first college and is the only college in the nation founded by an individual who would later become President of the United States. William Henry Harrison, the ninth U.S. President, founded VU while serving as governor of the Indiana Territory.

FOX RIDGE NATURE PARK

1364 N. Hillcrest Road, Vincennes

Part of the former Fox Ridge Golf Course, this 95-acre property was converted to public use as a nature park in early 2015. The purchase was paid for in part by Indiana's Bicentennial Nature Trust Grant Project. Development efforts are ongoing as a part of a Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund grant. The focus of Fox Ridge Nature Park is to provide the public a space for passive recreation, which means walking, hiking, bicycling, fishing, and exploring the natural world inhabiting the park.

A shelter house is also available.

Knox County Park system is home to wonderful wildlife and plant life preserves, campgrounds, fishing, and the perfect setting for naturalist activities to keep your family entertained.

OUABACHE TRAILS (pronounced Wabash)

3500 Lower Fort Knox Road, Vincennes

The 254-acre park is a naturally wooded area featuring steeply rolling hills and low flatlands covered with deciduous growth. Activity options include river fishing (foot access only), nature study, wildlife observation, RV and tent camping, picnicking, hiking, wildflower walks, basketball court, and photography.

Visitors can enjoy over 4 miles of walking and biking trails, 5 shelter houses, 4 playground areas, and a baseball field. Overnight accommodations include a campground with showers and laundry facilities. The park also offers 4 rustic log cabins available for rent.

HILLCREST PARK

Emison Mill-IN 550, Bruceville

A 20-acre park featuring white, red, and spruce pine trees that provide a habitat for small wildlife. The park offers a shelter house, picnic facilities, open play areas, and a dog park.

PYRAMID MOUND

1180 Ramsey Road, Vincennes

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, Pyramid Mound is undeveloped and accessible to foot traffic only.

Knox County Parks offer a wide range of recreational and natural experiences, fostering a healthy and enjoyable environment for both residents and visitors alike.

The Vincennes Parks & Recreation Department strives to provide quality parks and recreational facilities and services to the citizens of Vincennes. The Vincennes Parks consists of 4 parks offering shelter facilities for renting, lighted pickleball courts, sand volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, 2 walking trails; the Vaughn Trail and Tecumseh Walking Trail, Rainbow Beach Family Aquatic Center, Lester Square Skate Park, Lester Square Fitness Park, Four Lakes Spray Park, fishing opportunities, and playground equipment at each of the parks.

FOUR LAKES PARK 1905 Lake Street

A family-friendly spot with opportunities for fishing, picnicking, and exploring nature, Four Lakes Park, offers several amenities.

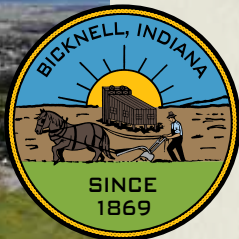

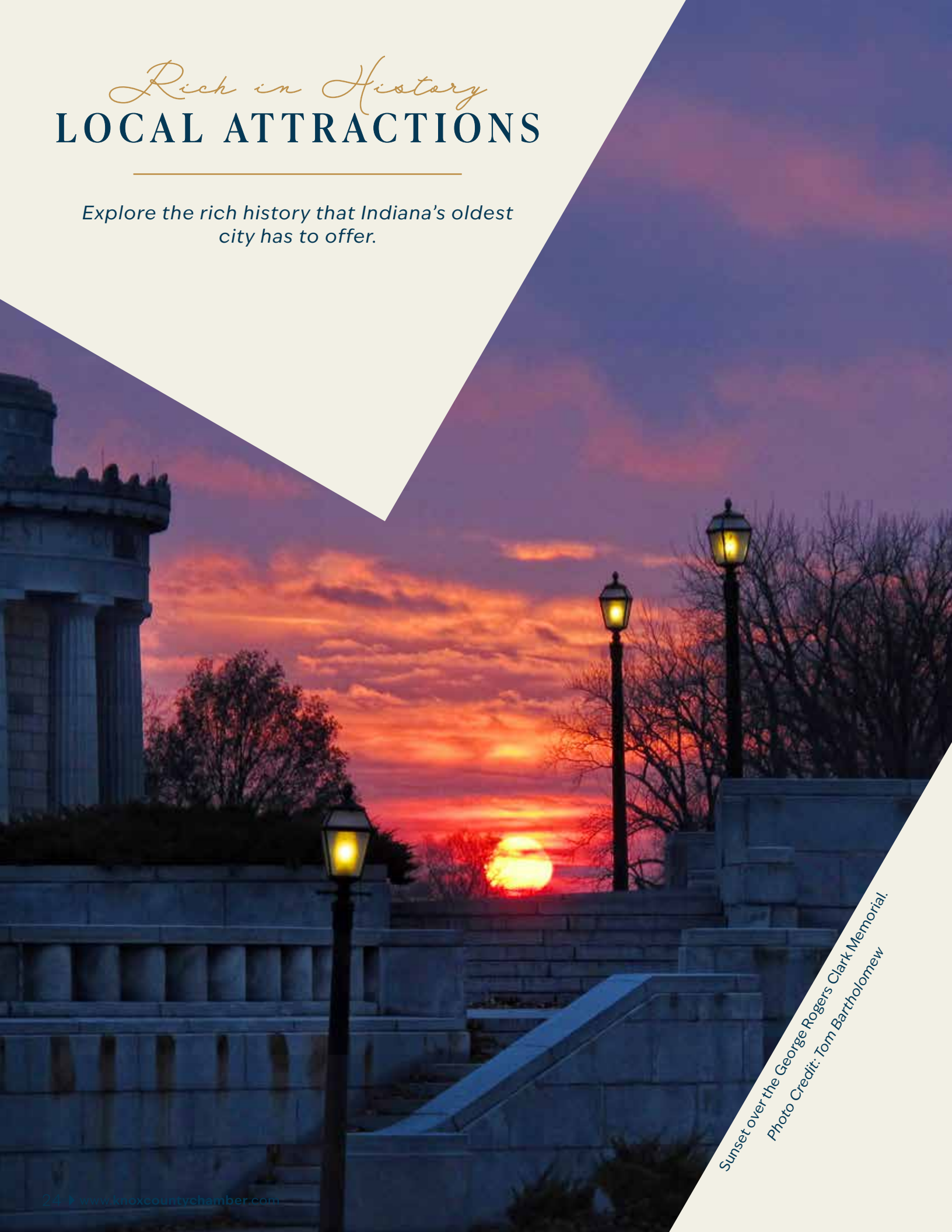

Throughout the year, visitors and residents enjoy reenactments at Indiana Military Museum, Summer on Main's music, First City Music Festival and First Friday Art Walks.

Of course, what truly makes Vincennes shine is its people. Sing along during the annual Christkindlmarkt caroling in Victorian outfits, or during one of the trolley pub crawls, or during one of Old Town Players' musicals.

THE RED

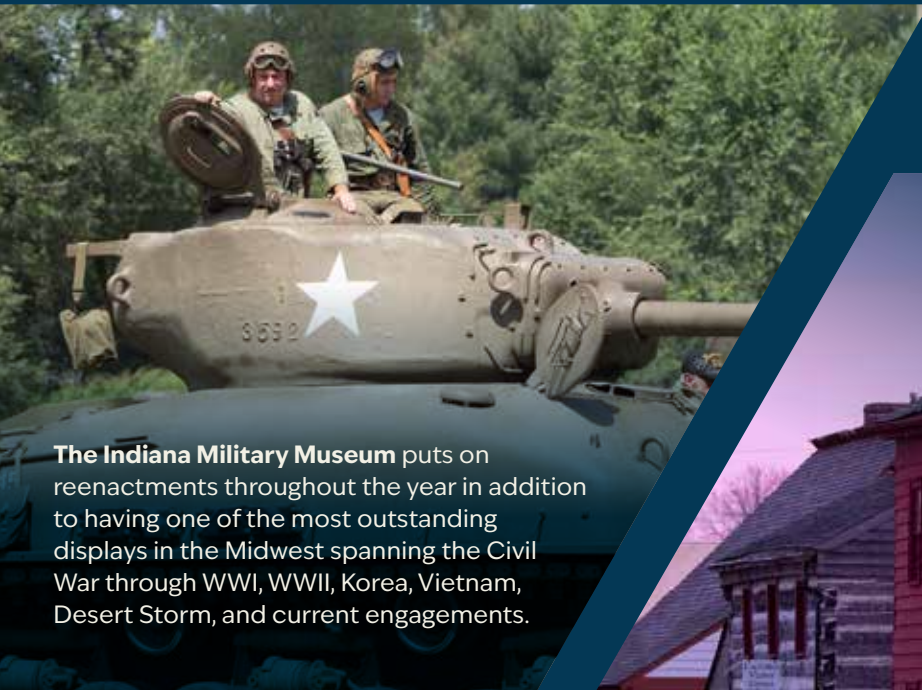
The Red Skelton Performing Arts Center, the Red Skelton Museum of American Comedy and the Lothian and Red Skelton Gallery of Fine Arts, collectively known as "The Red", combine to enhance the cultural scene in Vincennes and Knox County. Whether you are hoping to catch a performance, spend some time in the museum learning more about Red Skelton's Legacy of Laughter or checking out the latest exhibit in the art gallery, The Red is definitely the place to be! The beautiful Red Skelton Performing Arts center opened in 2006 and hosts many shows each year including the VU Alumni Community Series, plays and musicals from the VU drama department and many musical performances from the VU music department. In addition to the offerings from the University, other community groups often bring in spectacular shows to this beautiful theater. The Red Skelton Museum of American Comedy opened in 2013 and is an interactive tribute to the legacy of laughter of comedian and Vincennes native, Red Skelton. Red was not only a comedian, but also a painter, author and composer and the Lothian and Red Skelton Gallery of Fine Art opened in 2025 to celebrate his creative genius with a large display of his works of art.



The Red hosts events throughout the year that provide fun for the entire family including gallery exhibits, concerts, and an annual Convention and Clown Parade held each summer.

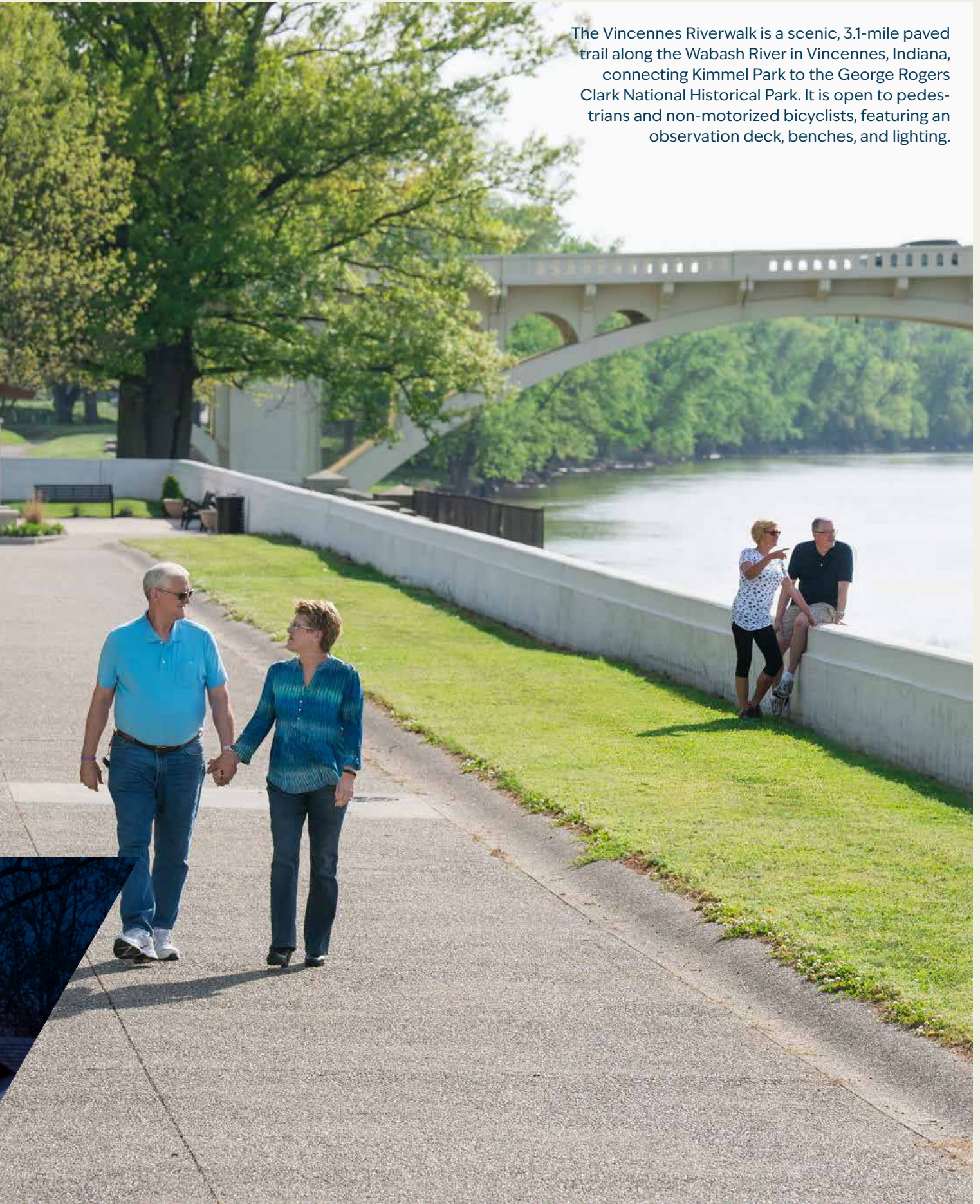

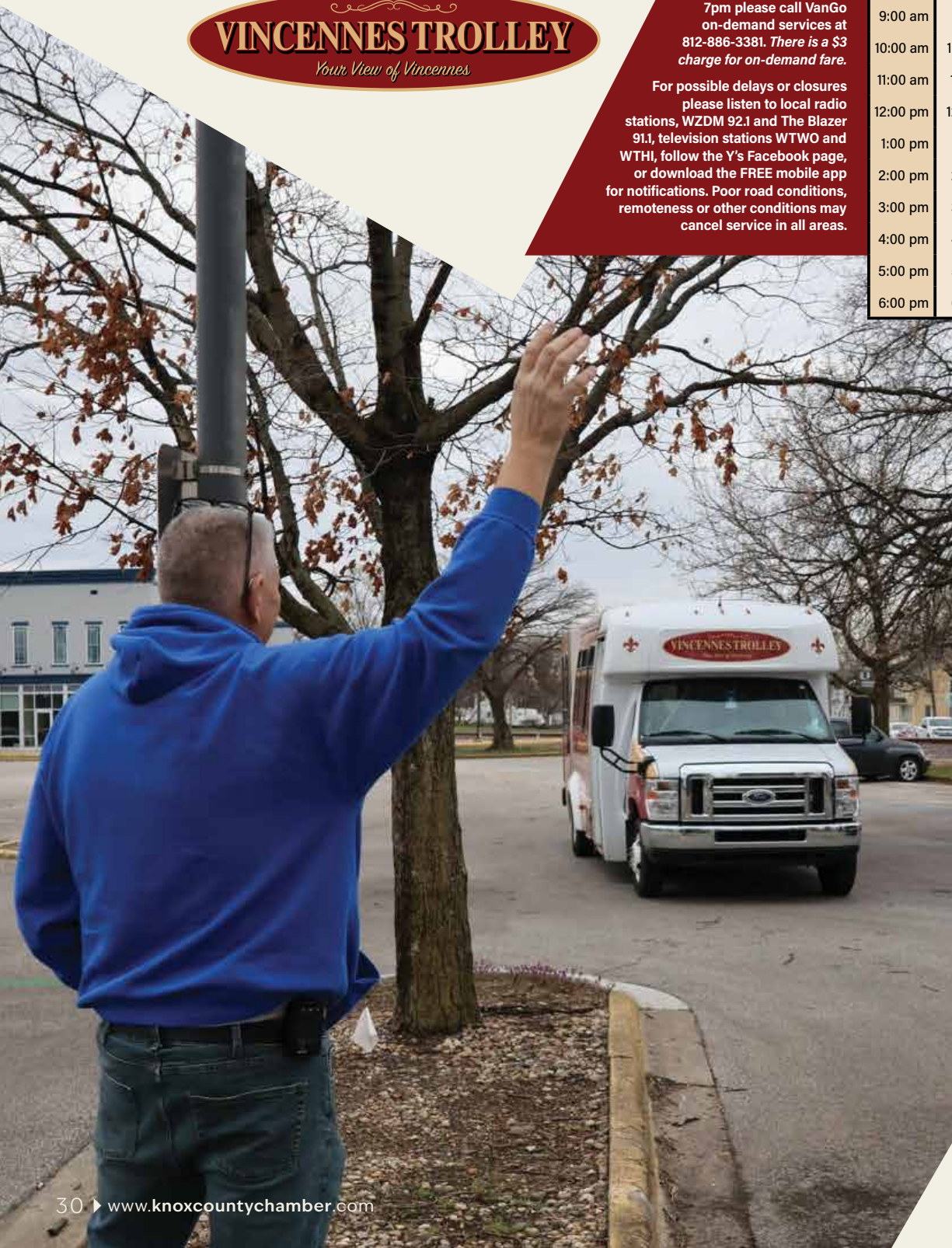

ALL ABOARD THE VINCENNES TROLLEY

A simple ride across town can make a big difference. The Vincennes Trolley is doing just that by providing a free and convenient way for people to travel throughout Knox County. Created through a partnership between the City of Vincennes, VanGo, and the YMCA, the trolley was designed to make everyday transportation easier and more accessible for everyone.

The trolley follows a fixed route with more than 50 designated stops throughout the city. It connects neighborhoods with shopping areas, medical offices, and popular destinations including Vincennes University. Riders can wait at a marked stop and signal the driver as the trolley approaches. A mobile tracking app also allows passengers to see the trolley's real time location, making it simple to plan trips and reduce wait times.

Since beginning service in late 2024, the trolley has been met with strong interest from the community. Early ridership exceeded expectations, showing that there was a clear need for dependable public transportation. For residents without access to a personal vehicle, the trolley provides a reliable way to get to work, attend appointments, pick up groceries, or simply enjoy time downtown. Students, seniors, and visitors have also found it to be a convenient way to move around the city.

Beyond convenience, the trolley plays an important role in daily life. By making it easier for people to reach local shops, restaurants, and services, it helps keep activity flowing throughout Vincennes. It supports independence, expands access to opportunity, and encourages exploration of everything the city has to offer.

WHAT IS YOUR GREATEST RETIREMENT FEAR?

Many thoughts may go through your head when asked this question but perhaps the most common response is “outliving my money.” Longevity risk is greater today than it has ever been. The Census Bureau says that Americans typically retire around age 62 for women and 65 for men. Social Security projects that today’s 63-year-old will live into their mid-eighties, on average. Retirement can last 20, 30, even 40 years or more for some.

Investors are aware that investing in the capital markets presents any number of risks and risk is an inseparable companion for long-term growth. During your accumulation years, you likely categorized your risk as “conservative,” “moderate,” or “aggressive” and that guided how your portfolio was built. What occurs with many retirees is a change in mindset and more consistent performance is desired. It may be less about a risk continuum that stretches from conservative to aggressive and more about balancing the objectives of maximizing and sustaining income for a lifetime.

Investors are routinely warned about allowing their emotions influence their decisions but are often not cautioned about how their preconceptions and biases may impact their financial choices. In a battle between facts and biases, our biases may win. Information that seems abstract may seem less valid than information related to personal experience. The latest news is often more valuable than old news in the investment world but when it is consistently good (or consistently bad), memories of previous market climates may become too distant. If we are not careful, our minds may subconsciously dismiss the eventual emergence of the next market cycle. Recent success can cause overconfidence and the news cycle and can lead investors into the herd mentality of promoting panic selling or a fear of missing out.

As an investor, you face another, lesser-known risk which is not easily reduced through diversification yet may be the biggest challenge to the sustainability of your retirement income - “sequence of return risk.” This refers to the uncertainty of the order of returns an investor will receive over an extended period of time. Averages can hide dangerous possibilities. You may be comfortable that the market will deliver its historical average return over the long-term, but you can never know when you will be receiving the varying positive and negative returns that comprise the average. The order in which you receive these returns can make a big difference. Sequence of return risk is especially problematic in retirement. Down years, in combination with portfolio withdrawals taken to provide income have the potential to seriously damage the ability of your savings to recover sufficiently, even as the markets rebound.

If you are nearing retirement or already in retirement, it’s time to give serious consideration to the “sequence of returns risk” and ask questions about how you can better manage your portfolio. The march of time affords us ever-changing perspectives on life, and that is never more true than during retirement. Creating a strategy may help you better prepare.

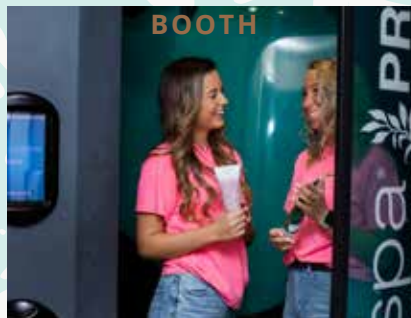

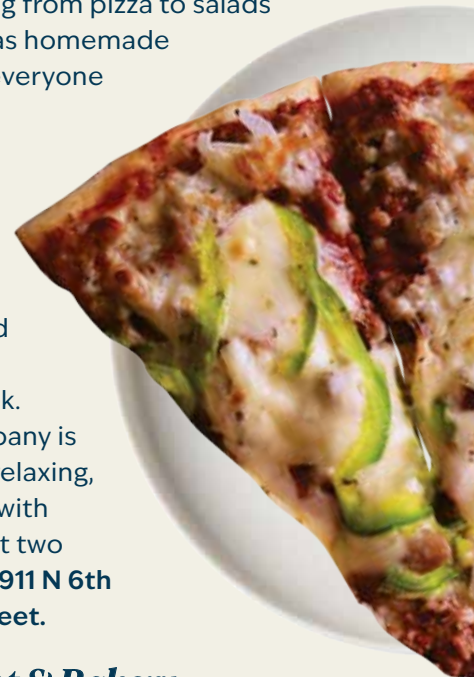

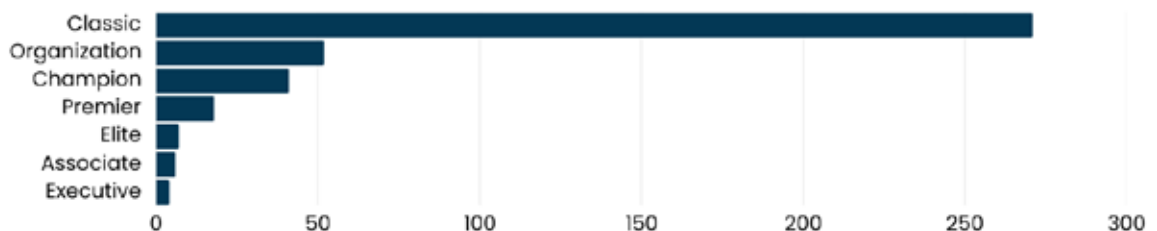
